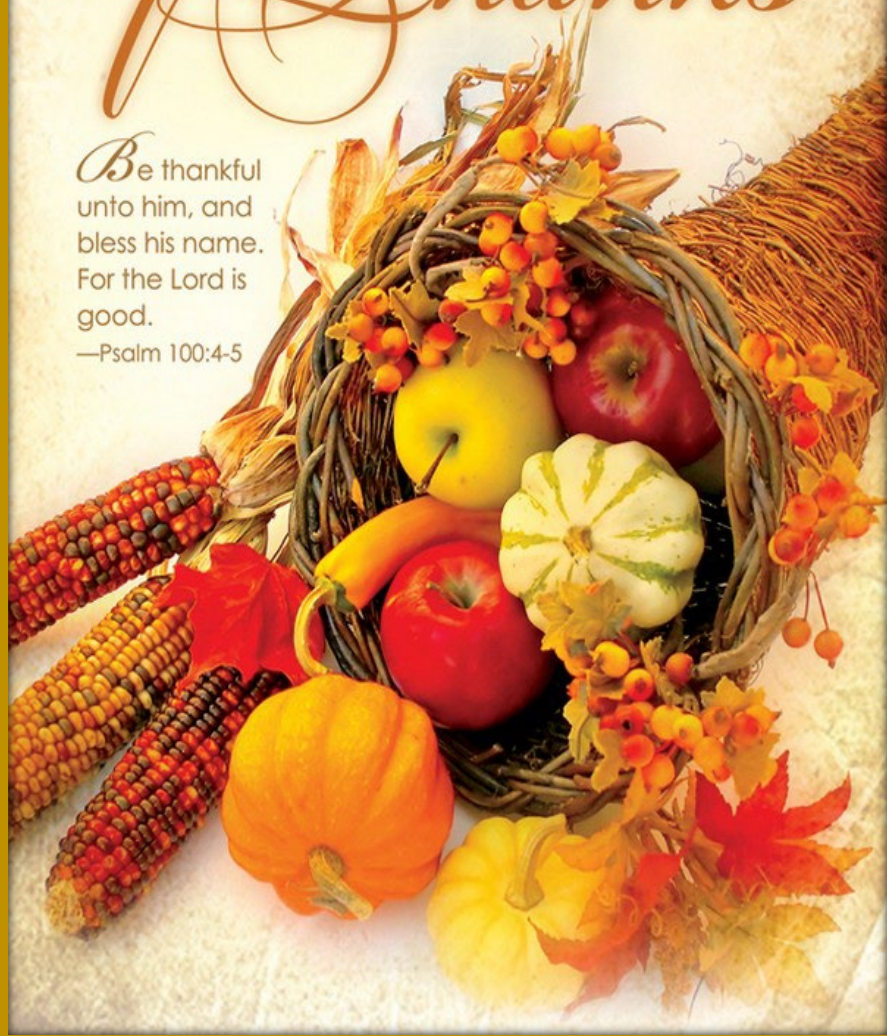


LET US ALL *Give Thanks*
